A unique part of “Bands Across the Prairie” is the opportunity for students and staff from each competing band to immediately view, on a 20-foot screen, a professionally recorded DVD of the show they just performed, along with expert suggestions for improvement by one of our three Critique Clinicians. Our outstanding facilities allow us to alternate bands between adjacent critique centers: our new state-of-the-art 1,000-seat Concert Hall and our existing 500-seat Theatre. Each critique venue provides air-conditioned comfort along with ice-cold bottles of water and the opportunities for outstanding viewing, listening, and learning experiences.

Admission prices for this exciting event are \$6 for adults, and \$4 for students and senior citizens. Concessions will also be available.
