# Summer 2014 Weekly Themes:

#### Session 1: Week of June 29 - Critter Quest

Each camper unit will plan and carry out it's own expedition to explore Camp Hitaga's many acres in search of critters of all kinds. Creatures great and small, our young explorers will find, craft, photograph, learn about and role-play them all during this Sunday - Wednesday session! #### Session 2: Week of July 6 - Hunger Games

Putting a non-violent, positive spin on these novels-turned-films, campers will focus on developing their archery and survival skills, participate in pageantry, and make video diaries reflecting on their experiences. Classic Camp \* Stirrups & Saddles \* Netahi

#### Session 3: Week of July 13 - Lights, Camera, Action!

The creative arts take center stage this week, as campers plan and produce skits, photo essays, story-boards or dioramas illustrating topics of their choosing, or portraying their week at camp. Mini-Camp \* Classic Camp \* Stirrups & Saddles \* Netahi

#### Session 4: Week of July 20 - Hitaga Island

Survivors come in all shapes and sizes! This week campers will build individual survival skills and then take on challenges that emphasize teamwork - from building a raft and crafting a message in a bottle to planning a group overnight in a Treehouse or tent camping in a meadow. # **Summer 2014 Program Options**



## **Mini Camp**

Mini Camp is a 3-day resident camp program designed for youth new to Camp Hitaga. Mini-campers will be introduced to a variety of activities offered at Camp Hitaga such as archery, campcraft (survival skills), drama, handarts (arts & crafts), nature adventures, aquatic games, evening programs, campfires and more. Mini campers may sign up for an optional horseback ride or two during check-in at camp for a small additional fee. **New in 2014**, Mini Campers will get to plan and conduct a Wednesday lunch cookout! Sessions run Sunday afternoon-Wednesday 5 PM. **Session 1** Mini Camp is open to and designed for **ALL ages** (entering 1st - 12th grade in the fall). **Session 3** & **Session 5** Mini Camps are designed for and open to next fall's 1st - 4th graders only.

#### **Classic Camp**

A week-long resident camp for campers entering 1st - 12th grade, Classic Camp offers a progression of activities, based each camper's age, as outlined in the "Unit" descriptions below. All Classic Campers participate in weekly theme activities during afternoon and evening programs, and may, for a small additional fee to be paid during check-in at camp, sign up for optional horseback rides. Sessions run Sunday afternoon-Saturday morning.

2014 Program Fee: Early Bird \$439 \* After May 20: \$459



"Aponita" (entering grades 1, 2 and 3). Like Mini-campers, Aponitas will experience a variety of activities, but as Classic Campers, they will then have an opportunity to repeat their favorites at the end of the week. Aponitas may choose to plan and go on an overnight (tent camping or under the stars) in main camp.

"Shabonda" (entering grades 4, 5 & 6) Shabonda campers add the Challenge Course and canoeing to their activity list, and choose two specialties. They may also choose to work together during the week to plan a day-long or one-night canoeing or backpacking trip to the more remote parts of camp or other nearby natural areas.

"Agatih" (entering grade 7 and up)
As well as all the options open to Shabonda campers, Agatihs may choose to specialize further in the activity areas of their choice. Entering grade 9 and up may choose to begin assisting counselors in presenting activities to younger campers. Agatih campers have a slightly later bedtime.

# **Stirrups & Saddles**

This is Camp Hitaga's horse-specialty program for campers entering 4th - 12th grade next fall. Campers will be placed in beginner, intermediate or advanced riding lessons based on Camp Hitaga riding staff's assessment of each camper's skills at the beginning of each session. In addition to riding, Stirrups & Saddles campers will learn and practice principles of caring for and partnering with a horse. Stirrups & Saddles Program takes place mornings; campers participate in activities with the rest of camp during the balance of the day. Sessions run Sunday afternoon - Saturday morning. Maximum 12 campers per week.

2014 Program Fees: Mini-session (Wk 1 only): Early Bird \$275 \* After May 20: \$289 Full sessions (Wks 2 - 5): Early Bird \$469 \* After May 20: \$489



## **Canoe Gypsy**



For campers entering 6th - 12th grade who have relevant experience, Week 4 (July 20-26) offers the challenge of a three-day canoe trip. Campers will plan and prepare, then take water and food with them and work as a team, cooking and living in the outdoors as they camp out along the river. Pre-trip evenings are filled with fun all-camp and age-unit activities, including weekly theme activities. Friday evening the Canoe Gypsy group will join in the all-camp closing Council Fire. Prerequisites for this trip include good swimming skills and some previous experience (whether at Camp Hitaga or elsewhere) canoeing, cooking out and/or tent camping.

Session runs Sunday afternoon - Saturday morning with river trip Wednesday through Friday.

Almost all Health Center visits are minor and can be treated by camp's trained personnel. I may not be notified if my child receives minor treatment or medicines. I further recognize and have instructed my child in the importance of knowing and abiding by the camp's rules, regulations and procedures for the safety of camp participants. If I have any questions or concerns about these policies, I will contact the Camp Director before my camper's session. In the event that I cannot be reached in an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the Camp Director to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for and to order injection and/or surgery for my child as named on this form. I understand that both the balance of the camp fee and a signed Health Form are due two weeks prior to the session my child will be attending or a \$20 late fee will be assessed and my child may lose his or her session of choice.
