National Czech & Slovak Museum & Library July 14-18, 2014





Spend a week this summer learning from a Master Folk Artist! Decorate beautiful eggs using traditional techniques, discover the craft of Polish paper cutting, turn ordinary wheat and straw into works of art, and use dough to create cute Czech-style creatures that become keepsakes. There are 3 fun hands-on crafts each day.

Folk artist Daniela Sipkova Mahoney learned how to decorate eggs when she was a young girl in Czechoslovakia. She has continued this tradition, and has taught many cultural craft classes for both adults and children. Daniela has published many children's coloring and activity books, and enjoys teaching about Czech and Slovak heritage. She lives in Portland, Oregon.

Classes are tailored to children grades K-8. Snacks and craft materials will be provided. Students may pick and choose sessions, or attend the whole week. All projects are for beginners, and tailored to the age of the child. A waiver must be signed for each child. Please notify the NCSML if he/she has any dietary restrictions or disabilities so that we may accommodate them.

Monday, July 14 [Introduction to Czech & Slovak Folk Arts] 1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Decorate real eggs using Delft-style blue ink, learn the basics of Polish paper cutting, and create your own doll using wheat.

Tuesday, July 15 [Painted Eggs and Cute Critters] 1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Learn the drop-pull method for decorating eggs, make paper crafts using blue batik designs, and create adorable animals made of dough that are baked and sealed to create long-lasting mementos.





Wednesday, July 16 [Wonderful Wheat and Colorful Collages] 1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Find out how to weave a small basket out of wheat, learn intricate paper cutting using traditional embroidery designs, and discover the method of using straw to make intricately decorated eggs.





Thursday, July 17 [Designer for a Day] 1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Color your own traditional costumes, use Polish paper cutting techniques to create folk costume-inspired notecards, and learn to make ornamental designs using dough.

Friday, July 18 [Discovering Folk Costumes] 1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Make paper dolls in traditional Czech and Slovak folk costumes, create notecards inspired by folk dress using fabric, and use dough to build little people!
