clothes that can get dirty.

DAY CAMP PROGRAM GUIDE

Fish Iowa Day Camp

June 24-27th, Tues - Friday, 9 am – Noon
Pinicon Ridge Park near Central City
Student's ages 8 –14 will learn about fish, water habitat, tackle, knots, rods, reels and get to go fishing. The fee includes snacks and camp materials. Class size is limited. Many scout fishing badge requirements are met. Registration deadline: June 18. Cost: \$40 per child.

Woodcarving for Kids

Thursday, June 26th, 9 am – Noon
With the guidance of Cedar Valley Woodcarvers members, a few basic tools, scrap wood, and safety in mind, any child between the ages of 10-15 will be on their way to creating a walking stick made from Wickiup's own willow. Each participant will receive a willow stick on which to practice skills and carve a simple design. Materials and tools will be supplied for the class. Registration deadline: June 23. Cost: \$10 per child.

Fairy Houses and Stump Cities

Friday, June 27th, 10 am – Noon
The simple challenge of creating a fairy house gives children a unique activity that encourages them to go outside and connect with the natural world. We will collect items from nature and make pieces out of clay to help complete our houses. Sticks, bark, dry grasses, pebbles, shells, feathers, pine cones and nuts are just some of the natural materials used. For ages 5+.
Registration Deadline: June 20 Cost: \$10 per child.

Native American Skills Day Camp

Thursday, July 10th, 9am - Noon
Step back in time to learn traditional Native American skills. Make your own atlatl, create a bracelet by finger weaving and practice fire making. This camp is all about the lives of Native Americans. Registration deadline: July 8. Cost \$20 per child.

This program is also offered Tuesday, August 12th from 9am - Noon. Deadline to register is August 8th.

Be a Naturalist Day Camp

July 15-18, Tues - Friday, 9 am - 2 pm
Explore Wickiup Hill with local insect, reptile, bird and mammal experts. Learn how to catch and ID animals in the prairie, forest and wetlands. Come prepared to get wet and dirty and have a lot of fun. Children aged 8 -12. Registration deadline: July 10. Cost: \$60.00 per child. Bring a sack lunch.



Fossil Finders

July 16, Wednesday, 9 am – 2 pm
Have you always wanted to be a junior paleontologist? Kids work with a real paleontologist, touch real fossils, and make fossil casts. Each child will take home their discoveries. Ages 8+. Registration deadline: July 14. Cost: \$20 per child. Bring a sack lunch.

Archaeology Day Camp

July 22 – 24, 9 am – 2 pm
Hey kids, do you like to explore and learn about the past? Then come out and dig with us and learn how archaeologists find, investigate and interpret archaeological sites. We will spend part of a day in Mahaska County to participate in the University of Iowa Mammoth dig. Parents must provide a sack lunch. Day trip to Mahaska County will return around 4p.m. For children aged 8 -12. Registration deadline: July 18. Cost: \$65.00 per child.

'Hunger Games' themed Survival Camp
