Prairie's Anti-Bullying Promises:

- When we know that someone is being bullied, we will tell an adult at school and an adult at home.







Your child is listening and remembering your advice, even when it seems like he/she is not paying attention. In fact, spending 15 minutes a day listening and talking with your child can help build the foundation for a strong relationship and provide reassurance that he/she can come to you with a problem. It can also help your child recognize and respond to bullying.

A new mobile app by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), can help get the conversation started. You will find tips on talking about school, work, relationships, life, and bullying. Consider times to talk like, while making dinner, shopping, or anytime you and your child have 15 minutes together. The app also has a feature to remind you that it's time to talk.
