Maker Camp Descriptions:

Small group teams will work together to design, test, and improve toy vehicles as they explore A World In Motion.

<u>1st - 3rd Grade Camps:</u> Air Skimmer & Jet Car — Younger campers will build a table-top sail boat and then will advance to making a balloon-powered toy car.

<u>4th - 5th Grade Camps:</u> Elementary Jet Car & Gravity Cruiser — Older campers will build a balloon-powered toy car and then will advance to making a gravity-powered cruiser.


<u>6th - 8th Grade Camps:</u> <u>Middle School Jet Car & Gravity Cruiser</u> — Middle school campers will go more in depth as they also build a balloon-powered car, then advance to making a gravity-powered cruiser.

Drop Off/Pick Up Policy
