



Seeking Teens for a Research Study: Summer 2015

Attention Parents of Teens,

Girls 15-16 years of age and boys 15-18 years old are invited to take part in a research study about how the brain grows during the teenage years.

To qualify, a teen must have at least 1 biological parent with past or present issues related to their alcohol use. The goal of the study is to learn more about the genetic risk for developing issues with alcohol use.

Participants are asked to complete 1 visit, involving computer tasks, questionnaires, and an MRI scan (no radiation). They are paid \$175 and can earn up to an additional \$50 on one of the study tasks. Parents filling out family history forms will be compensated \$35.

Visits take place at the UI Hospitals and Clinics. For those coming from outside of Iowa City, mileage will be reimbursed. Siblings are welcome.
