The American Youth Soccer Organization is a volunteer, non-profit program designed to promote outdoor soccer. AYSO places the emphasis on providing children with a positive sports experience in a fun, safe, and fair environment. Volunteer coaches and referees are offered training clinics to assist in developing your child's knowledge of soccer skills & rules, teamwork, and sportsmanship. Each child, regardless of talent, plays at least one-half of every game. Girls and boys play on separate teams. Games are typically played on Saturdays at the Tuma Soccer Complex located at County Home Road & C Avenue Extension. Teams are coordinated around zip codes as enrollment figures support. AYSO has 500,000 soccer players. In our region, we have 2,350 players on 215 teams. Our players are from Cedar Rapids, Marion, Robins, Mount Vernon, Hilawatha, Vinton, Anamosa, Lisbon, Solon, Palo, Toddville, Central City and other cities in the surrounding areas.



AYSO is a nationwide non-profit organization that develops and delivers quality youth soccer programs in a fun, family environment based on AYSO's Six Philosophies:

Everyone Plays

Our program's goal is for kids to play soccer so we mandate that every player on every team must play at least 50% of every game.

Balanced Teams

Each year we form new teams as evenly balanced as possible because it's more fun and a better learning experience when teams of similar ability play.

Open Registration

Our program is open to all children between 4 and 18 years of age who want to register and play soccer. Interest and enthusiasm are the only criteria for playing. There are no try-outs and nobody gets cut.

Positive Coaching

Encouragement of player effort provides for greater enjoyment for the players and leads to better-skilled and better-motivated players.

Good Sportsmanship

We strive to create a positive environment based on mutual respect rather than a win-at-all-costs attitude, and our program is designed to instill good sportsmanship in every facet of AYSO.

We believe that all players should be able to develop their soccer skills and knowledge to the best of their abilities, both individually and as members of a team, in order to maximize their enjoyment of the game.
