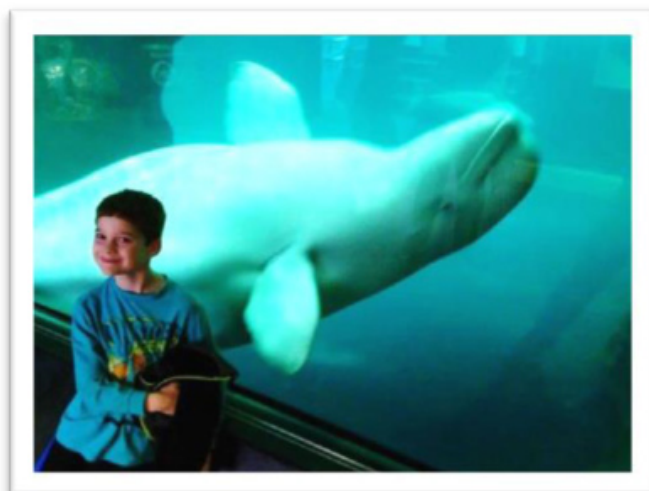
Cub Scouts Do Things and Go Places

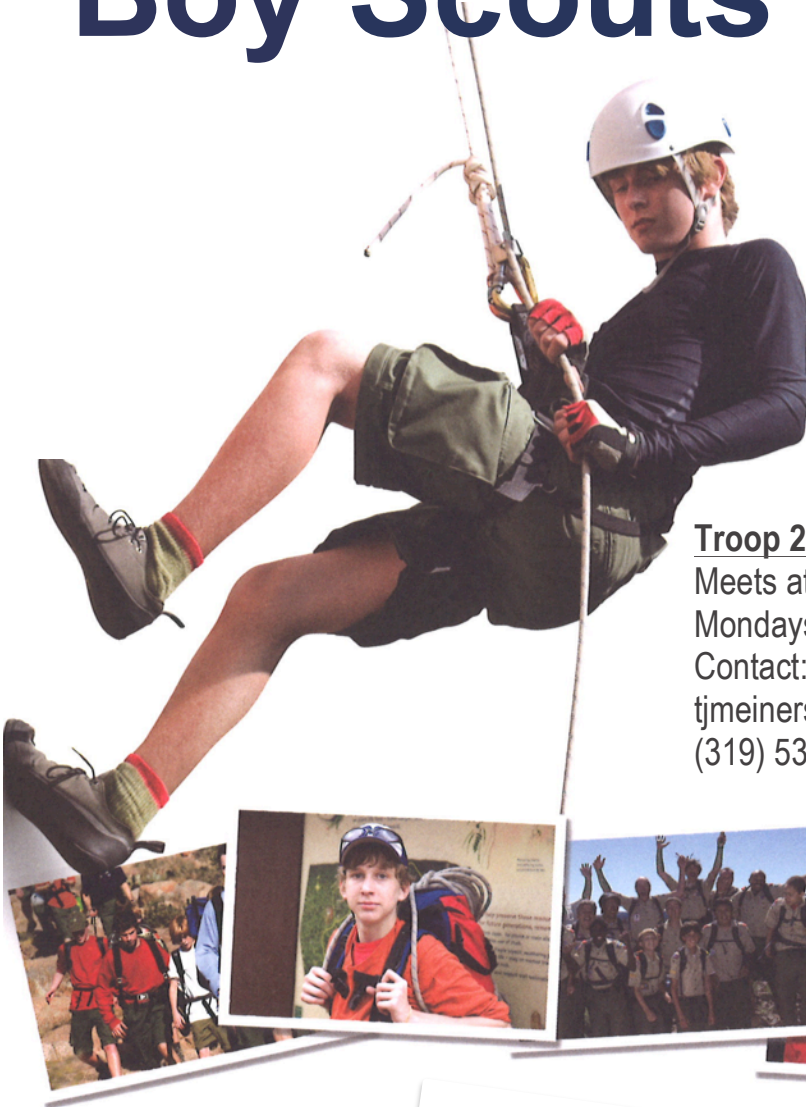

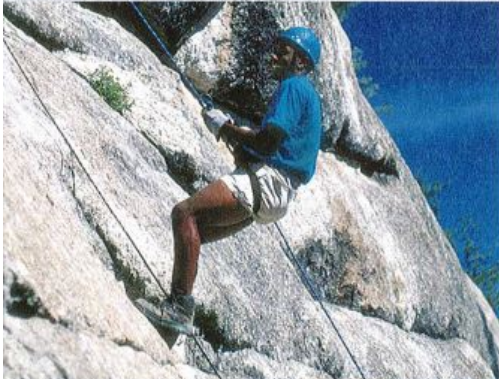
