Eligibility Requirements/Contest Rules

ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to all children, currently enrolled in grades Kindergarten through sixth grade except PREVIOUS NATIONAL WINNERS. Entry in the contest must be through a recognized sponsor.

RULES

- 1. All building projects must be completed where and when designated by the sponsor.
- 2. All building projects must be completed within the allotted time. Each participant shall have one hour to complete his/her project.
- 3. All building projects must be completed using approved materials only. Each participant shall have 100 blocks with which to complete the project. Use of specialty pieces (windows, doors, wheels, people, animals, etc.) shall be avoided and will disqualify regional and national entries. Each participant may also use up to three (3) additional items, supplied by the sponsor, from the following list:
 - 1. Small rock/stone
 - 2. String
 - 3. Foil
 - 4. Poster Board

*Each of these items may be broken or torn into smaller pieces, provided the child does so without outside assistance. *The use of scissors or knives is prohibited*. Each participant may use a combination of three items.

- 4. All building projects must be relevant to the construction industry. Projects which depict people or animals will not be allowed.
- 5. All building projects must be completed by entrant, with no outside assistance from parent, teachers, etc.
- 6. Every participant must submit the Official Registration/Entry Form, signed by a parent or guardian.
