Boot Camp 1-A1

This class will introduce your beginning artist to the variety of ways to form clay as well as a day of learning about glass fusing. A variety of products will be produced.

Storybook Clay

Create clay objects based on your favorite storybooks and fairy tales. Finish your creations using glazes, colored slips and paints.

Exploring Glass 1-C4

This class is centered around introducing the students to glass fusing. Using pre-cut glass, they will create projects that may include ornaments and sun catchers.

Egyptian Clay 2-E2 ★

The Egyptians were one of the first cultures to create pottery. In this class students learn about important Archeological discoveries in Egypt and create replicas of artifacts in clay.

A Pirate's Life for Me 2-F2 ★

Create your own pirate creations: a fantastic ship, treasure chest, parrots or skull and cross bones. Learn the basics of working with clay – coils, slabs, pinch pots and molds. Finish your creations using glazes, colored slips and paints.

Exploring Glass 2-K4

This class is centered around introducing the students to glass fusing. They will create projects using pre-cut glass that may include 3D bugs, ornaments and sun catchers.

Clay Unplugged 3-I2

Students can create instruments such as rain sticks, rattles, whistles, drums, etc. out of clay.

Animal Designs in Glass 3-A1

Create 3D animals using glass and wire. Add animal prints to glass frames. Design fish or butterfly mobiles. Make garden stakes with an animal theme. Glass included! .

Exploring Glass

Create unique designs and projects as you learn the fundamentals of glass fusing. You will have the opportunity to explore a wide variety of glass materials and techniques. Experience the expressive potential in this exciting medium to make window art, small jewelry pieces, magnets, and ornaments. Glass included!

Mi Amore Majolica 3-J2

Learn this Italian historical painting technique to decorate ceramic items with beautiful bright colors. Create your own vessels or use ones that we've already made.

Time Traveling in Clay 3-H2

Students learn about important Archaeological discoveries and recreate artifacts in clay. Possible projects include: Easter Island Heads, Tang Horse, Eye of Horus, Terra Cotta Warriors, Pre-Columbian Toys, and Iznik Tile.

MWF – July 6 to July 15, 9 - 11 am (no class July 4th)



Raku Clay (Ages 11-14+) 3-R2

Make a series of ceramic works to be fired in a raku kiln, a historic Japanese firing method in which pots are heated to 1900 degrees, pulled out hot and placed in a chamber full of combustibles. Learn about the process, the history, and the amazing results that can be achieved through this exciting firing technique.

MWF – June 27 to July 8, 1 - 3:30 pm (no class July 4th)

NOTE: July 8th class starts at noon for firing

Anime Figure 3-L4

Students will create a unique figure in this class. They can make a mini-me, an animal or even an action hero with accessories.

Comic-Clay 3-M4

Students will learn how to transfer their comic book images on to clay projects. We will teach you various techniques to create several KAPAM! and WOW! projects.

Clay Boot Camp 3-N4

This class will show you a variety of technique for working with clay including: wheel throwing, coiling and hand building. You will also learn to glaze your pieces and will be introduced to the techniques for firing your creations.

Create something from your favorite science fiction shows or stories—maybe a magical screwdriver or light saber?

Summer Internships at The Ceramics Center will give you valuable experiences working in a community studio. You will have the opportunity to assist teachers in our Summer Camps, learn to mix glazes, load and fire kilns and help around the studio. In return for 8-10 hours per week, you will receive 25 lbs of clay to build your own artwork and will be able to use any methods we have to fire your work. This is a great opportunity to get some work experience and develop work references.
