Educational Classes

The RARE Group is offering a variety of environmentally themed educational classes for schools, scouting organizations, senior organizations, pre-schools, families, service organizations and others. The classes have age-appropriate activities and information. The classes are taught by RARE volunteers with over 30 years combined experience in environmental education, conservation ethics and practices, wildlife management and ecology.

The RARE Group has state of Iowa and USFWS permits for Education with live animals, Rehabilitation of sick, injured or orphaned wildlife and Scientific collection and salvage. We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization staffed by volunteers.

Programs Offered

Raptors of Iowa (ROI): The RARE team will bring a live hawk and owl and talk with the groups about adaptations, habitat needs, ID characteristics, problems and concerns they face, status, things individuals can do to help and other topics. A question-and-answer session will follow the presentation.

Extended programs at our facility in Iowa City: We conduct classes that offer hands-on experience with a variety of educational materials (wings/feet/pellets) and discussions of work done to help sick and injured wildlife, migration issues, habitat needs and much more. These programs also include a live raptor presentation.

PowerPoint presentations or talk: We present slides and discussion about the work The RARE Group offers for a variety of wildlife-related issues and concerns.

All programs can be tailored to the interests/learning styles of the audience and are offered at a variety of dates and times.
