Preschool Programs are offered within College Community Schools' ECC, Hill, Crest, Heights, and Ridge buildings.

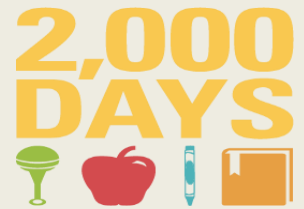
Due to construction at View Elementary View programming will be moved to the ECC building for the 2019-20 school year.

- Half Day Programing is available Monday-Thursday from 8:35-11:25 and 12:35-3:25.
- Limited full day Programing is available Monday-Thursday 9:00-3:00 at the ECC building.
- Shared Visions Programing is available to income eligible families at the ECC building: Monday-Thursday 9:00-3:00.
- Head Start Programing is available at the ECC building. Please contact 319-721-2794 for information.

To accommodate family needs wrap-around services are available within the same building your child will attend preschool. Wrap-around is available Monday-Friday from 6:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. This service is fee based. ECC accepts CCA, there are also a limited number of scholarships available courtesy of Linn County Early Childhood Iowa.
